## Capital Campaign Launched in Support of Thacher Visitor Center

NYS Parks Commissioner Rose Harvey and other state and local dignitaries joined the Friends of Thacher Park on June 2 at a groundbreaking event for the Thacher Visitor Center and launch of the associated capital campaign. Situated on a trailhead for the Park's iconic Indian Ladder Trail, the new Visitor Center will serve as a focal point for the Park and a source of information about Thacher's rich history, geology and recreational opportunities.

According to Parks, New York State is providing \$3.8 million for construction of the Center, which will commence this summer, and is expected to be completed in 2016. In conjunction with that funding, a \$1 million private fund-raising Campaign has been launched for exhibits and displays, and to maintain the Center as a viable resource for Thacher's next 100 years. At the time of the groundbreaking, the Campaign has already raised \$380,000.

In the words of Commissioner Harvey in the Campaign video (access information below), Thacher Park was established thanks to a public-private partnership, with Emma Treadwell Thacher's gift of much of the park proper to NYS in 1914. The Campaign in support of the Visitor Center continues the proud tradition of NY citizens galvanizing in support of our Park, and will serve to instill the building with the unique local flavor and history of the Park and its surroundings.

About the Campaign, Friends of Thacher State Park President John Kilroy says, "Consistent with our mission to support and promote the Park, the Friends of Thacher State Park embrace the Center and Capital Campaign as a next important step in the revitalization of Thacher. We welcome this new era in the evolution of the Park and increased opportunity for an even broader audience to experience the Helderberg Escarpment's beauty, geology and history."

She received a BA in Physical Geography and Conservation from the State University College at Buffalo, NY in 1982. After graduating, she took graduate courses in environmental studies and, in 1983-1984, was awarded an internship with the DEC-NYS Department of Environmental Conservation. In 1984, Maureen worked as a seasonal naturalist with the Schoellkopf Geological Museum, interpreting the geology and natural history of Niagara Falls and the Niagara Gorge, and was appointed there as Environmental Educator in 1985. During her time at the Museum and with the Interpretive Department, Maureen developed and opened two nature centers. In 2000, Maureen developed a new nature center at Woodlawn Beach State Park, which included developing on site and off site programming as well as exhibit content and design. Maureen was appointed Park Manager of Maintenance and Grounds at Beaver Island State Park in 2010. Maureen has been at Thacher Park since May 23rd. Maureen and her husband David have been married for 28 years; they have three children. They are loving every minute in this beautiful part of the state.
